Bus Conduct

School transportation is a student privilege conditional upon satisfactory behavior on buses and at bus stops.

Students will be advised that, while awaiting or receiving transportation to and from school, they may be suspended from transportation services for unsatisfactory conduct which endangers persons or property or violates a Board of Directors' policy or administrative regulation. Principals shall follow procedures in Policy [5114](#) Suspension/Expulsion/Exclusion/Removal when suspending student bus privileges.
